

# Day Trip to Zurich & Lucerne

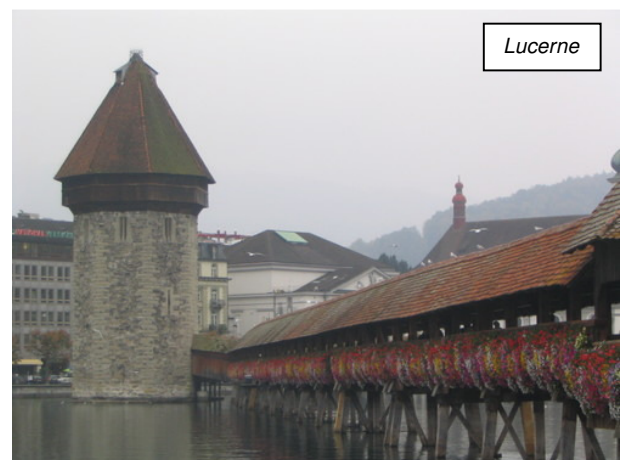

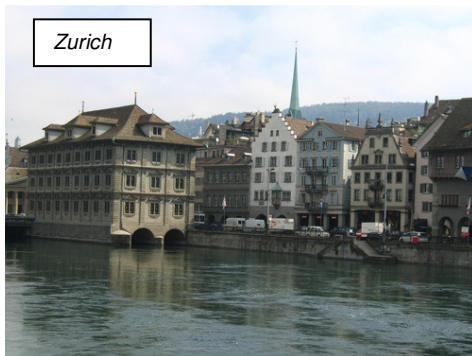

Most of **Zurich's attractions** lie around the relatively small area of the *Hauptbahnhof* and **Lake Zurich**. Here you will find the *Old Town* full of churches and burgher houses as well as the exclusive shopping in the *Bahnhofstrasse* area. Along the river Limmet, which divides the city, and the lake, you will find pleasant walkways and green areas.

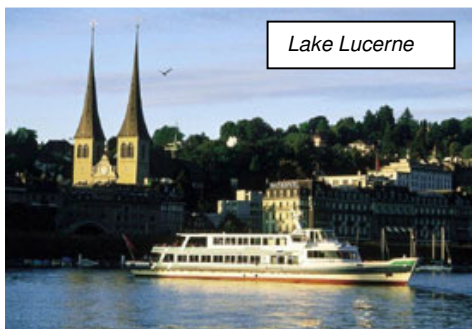
**Lucerne** (Twinned with Bournemouth) is a busy university town at the western end of Lake Lucerne and from here steamers set out for the other towns on the lake. Lucerne is famous for its two covered bridges decorated with medieval paintings, but also boasts a good castle, excellent modern shops, museums and galleries.

On arrival at Zurich Airport at approx. 0915 hrs, you will board your escorted coach for the journey to Zurich, Switzerland's largest city and commercial capital. Your tour will take in most of the city's attractions including the Grossmünster and Fraumünster (two very distinctive churches), the Baroque Rathaus (Town Hall) and St Peterskirche Church (which has the largest clock face in the world). Between the Hauptbahnhof and the lake is the Old Town, full of churches and burgher houses, and the exclusive shopping area of the Bahnhofstrasse. Continue on the scenic journey to Lucerne (twinned with Bournemouth) whilst enjoying the stunning landscape en route. This once medieval town is set on the shores of the famous lake, enveloped by the impressive panorama of the Swiss Alps and nestling at the foot of **Mount Pilatus**. A sightseeing tour will include the two exquisite wooden bridges, the **Mill Bridge** and the **Chapel Bridge** with the 13th century octagonal **Water Tower**, the famous **Lion Monument** and the **Old Town Hall**. The **City Wall** stands proud above the city and the **Glacier Garden**, a geological phenomenon, is proof that Lucerne was once covered by glaciers. After the tour you will have free time to have lunch (not included) and enjoy the pure charm of Lucerne, the many Renaissance buildings, the Baroque fountains and the spectacular views and sights which abound from almost every vantage point. **An optional boat trip will be offered on the day - further details available nearer to departure date.**
